

*FY 22/23 a/o 03/31/23


California's Real Estate Industry

Brokers: 29% Salespersons: 71%


Change from 2022 (07/01 through 03/31)





Broker Exams Administered July 1st – March 31st

Continuing Education (CE) Courses (SB 263)

- 1. Adds Interactive Participatory Component to Fair Housing Course
- 2. Adds Two-Hour Implicit Bias Course
 - Component regarding impact of implicit bias, explicit bias, and systemic bias on consumers, as well as historical & social impact of those biases
- 3. Updates Survey Course from Eight to Nine Hours to Allow for New Implicit Bias Content

- 3007.2- Refines Terms of a Material Change
 3013.1- Defines Parameters for Those Licensees Impacted
 3015- Defines Interactive Participatory Component*
- 3017- Fair Housing Course Requirements Briefly Outlined

New Continuing Education Requirements (Interactive Participatory Component)

The term "Interactive participatory component," as used in Business and Professions Code section 10170.5 means instruction whereby the instructor actively involves the students in their learning process through instructor-student interaction and/or through guided student-student interaction.




